

## **Driving Project Capital Efficiency: Strategic Alignment for Competitive Investment Decision and Effective Project Delivery**

**(RT-DCC-07, Capital Efficiency Scorecard for Downstream and Chemicals Projects)**

*Capital projects create value for owners, contractors, and service providers. Over the last 38 years, CII has helped capital projects improve their predictability and performance by developing practices focused on the project delivery process, from front end planning to startup. However, there is an opportunity to support more competitive investment decisions and effective project delivery that improve capital efficiency. This requires early engagement and strategic alignment of key stakeholders from the business organizations, capital project teams, and operations groups, representing owners, contractors, suppliers, and service providers.*

*Research Team DCC-07 was formed to identify ways to drive capital project efficiency. The presentation will make the case for this engagement and strategic alignment. It will discuss steps to promote them by developing a capital efficiency scorecard to assess the implementation of management processes that drive capital efficiency.*
